- 3. ICNU is an incorporated, non-profit association of large industrial electric customers in the Pacific Northwest, with offices in Portland, Oregon. A list of ICNU members is included as Attachment A. Many of ICNU's members are customers of PGE, as shown on Attachment A.
- 4. On July 1, 2011, PGE filed testimony associated with its 2010 Annual Power Cost Variance Mechanism ("PCAM") with the Oregon Public Utility Commission ("OPUC," or the "Commission"). PGE claims that its actual power costs for the 2010 calendar year period were \$12.4 million lower than the forecasted power costs in rates; however, PGE's PCAM includes a "deadband" under which small differences between actual and forecast net power costs are not charged or refunded to customers. ICNU requests leave to intervene in this Docket to represent its members who are affected by the operation of PGE's 2010 PCAM, and to investigate whether customers should receive refunds.
- 5. ICNU has extensive experience with PGE's rates and with previous proceedings related to PGE's power cost mechanism. ICNU's intervention in this proceeding will assist the Commission in resolving the issues and will not unreasonably broaden the issues, burden the record, or delay this proceeding.

6. As described above, ICNU has a direct and substantial interest in this

proceeding that will not be adequately represented by any other party, and may be affected by

any Commission determination made in connection with these proceedings. Therefore, it is in

the public interest to allow ICNU to intervene in this proceeding.

WHEREFORE, ICNU respectfully requests that the Commission grant its petition

to intervene with full party status in this proceeding.
