Pursuant to ORS § 756.525 and OAR § 860-001-0300(2), the Industrial Customers of Northwest Utilities (“ICNU”) hereby petitions the Oregon Public Utility Commission (“Commission”) to intervene in this proceeding with full party status as described in OAR § 860-001-0010(7). 3. ICNU is an incorporated, non-profit association of large industrial electric customers in the Pacific Northwest, with offices in Portland, Oregon. A list of ICNU members is included as Attachment A. Many of ICNU's members are customers of PacifiCorp, as shown on Attachment A.

4. ICNU has a substantial interest in PacifiCorp's Advice No. 13-004, offering a five-year cost of service opt-out program to qualified customers, filed on February 28, 2013 in Docket No. UM 1587. The Commission has opened Docket No. UE 267 in order to address the Company's proposal to change its tariffs.

5. ICNU is a party to Docket No. UM 1587, which generated this proceeding. ICNU has extensive experience with issues relating to direct access, as well as proceedings involving PacifiCorp's rates. ICNU's intervention in this proceeding will assist the Commission in resolving the issues and will not unreasonably broaden the issues, burden the record, or delay this proceeding.

6. As described above, ICNU has a direct and substantial interest in this proceeding that will not be adequately represented by any other party, and may be affected by any Commission determination made in connection with these proceedings. It is in the public interest to allow ICNU to intervene in this proceeding.

WHEREFORE, ICNU respectfully requests that the Commission grant its petition to intervene with full party status in this proceeding.
