3. AWEC is an incorporated, non-profit association of large energy consumers in the Western United States, with offices in Portland, Oregon. Many members of AWEC are customers of PacifiCorp (or “Company”).

4. On March 1, 2022, PacifiCorp filed its 2023 Transition Adjustment Mechanism, the purpose of which is to update net power costs for 2023 and to set transition credits for Oregon customers who choose direct access in the November open enrollment window. The calculation of such costs and how they are passed along to customers will substantially and directly affect those of AWEC’s members who purchase power from PacifiCorp. AWEC requests leave to intervene in this Docket to represent its members who are affected by any change to PacifiCorp’s rates and programs.

5. AWEC represents the interests of a number of large customers served by PacifiCorp in Oregon. AWEC also has significant experience participating in proceedings involving PacifiCorp’s rates and programs. AWEC’s intervention in this proceeding will assist the Commission in resolving the issues in this proceeding and will not unreasonably broaden the issues, burden the record, or unreasonably delay this proceeding.

6. As described above, AWEC has a direct and substantial interest in this proceeding that will not be adequately represented by any other party, and may be affected by
