Pursuant to ORS § 756.525 and OAR § 860-012-0001, the Industrial Customers of Northwest Utilities ("ICNU") petitions the Public Utility Commission of Oregon ("OPUC" or the "Commission") to intervene in this proceeding with full party status as described in OAR § 860-011-0035(5). In support of this petition, ICNU represents as follows:

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3. ICNU is an incorporated, non-profit association of large industrial electric

customers in the Pacific Northwest, with offices in Portland, Oregon. A list of ICNU members is

included as Attachment A.

4. ICNU has a substantial interest in the establishment and implementation of

an automatic adjustment clause by Avista under Senate Bill ("SB") 408. SB 408 seeks to ensure

that amounts that Oregon utilities collect in rates for income taxes reflect the amounts that those

utilities or the consolidated group of which the utility is a member actually pay to units of

government. This proceeding is addressing the establishment and implementation of an

automatic adjustment clause in accordance with section 3(4) of SB 408 in order to consider an

adjustment to rates related to taxes actually paid by Avista or the affiliated group of which Avista

is a member. As large industrial electric ratepayers who pay substantial amounts in charges for

income tax expenses included in electric rates, ICNU's members have an interest in the

Commission's implementation of tax adjustment clauses.

5. ICNU is a party to Docket Nos. UE 177 and UE 178, which are similar

proceedings for PacifiCorp and Portland General Electric ("PGE"), respectively. Originally,

ICNU's interests were particular to PacifiCorp and PGE's tax filings. However, ICNU now

understands that Docket No. UG 171 encompasses issues which impact all SB 408 tax-related

companies, and ICNU requests that it be allowed to intervene out of time in the interests of its

members. ICNU has demonstrated good cause to intervene out of time because it was not

originally apparent that Docket No. UG 171 would address issues relevant to PacifiCorp and

PGE.

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6. ICNU's intervention in this proceeding will assist the Commission in

resolving the issues and will not unreasonably broaden the issues, burden the record, or delay

this proceeding.

7. As described above, ICNU has a direct and substantial interest in this

proceeding that will not be adequately represented by any other party, and may be affected by

any Commission determination made in connection with these proceedings. It is in the public

interest to allow ICNU to intervene in this proceeding.

WHEREFORE, ICNU respectfully requests that the Commission grant its petition

to intervene with full party status in this proceeding.
