- 8 The Company is an electric public utility in the state of Oregon and is subject to the
- 9 jurisdiction of the Public Utility Commission of Oregon (Commission). The Company
- 10 collects public purpose funds from its customers, a portion of which is provided to the
- 11 Energy Trust of Oregon to manage energy efficiency programs in the Company's service
- 12 territory.
- 13 4. The issues the Company intends to raise in this proceeding are:
- Issues related to the performance measures proposed by the Energy Trust of Oregon.
- 15 5. The special knowledge or expertise of the Company that would assist the
- 16 Commission in resolving the issues in the proceeding is:
- 17 As an electric utility, the Company is subject to complying with the requirement to
- collect public purpose funds from its customers and in turn provide a portion of those funds
- 19 to the public purpose fund administrator (Energy Trust of Oregon). In turn, the Energy Trust
- 20 of Oregon operates and manages certain energy efficiency programs in the Company's
- service territory. The Company intends to review the proposed performance measures and/or
- 22 the proposed changes to the existing performance measures in order to provide comments
- and suggest modifications where necessary.
