3. The petitioner is a nonprofit environmental advocacy organization with more than

18,500 members residing in the State of Oregon. The organization's purposes include helping the Pacific Northwest achieve a sustainable and affordable electrical energy future, with special emphasis on investment in all cost-effective

energy efficiency and renewable resources.

- 4. Petitioner's interest in the proceeding reflects PacifiCorp very substantial influence over Oregon's portfolio of energy investments and the state's (and region's) environmental quality. The company is among the Northwest's largest investors in energy efficiency and renewable energy as well as the region's largest single emitter of global warming pollution. The proposed acquisition could significantly affect (for either good or ill) the Company's capacity to contribute to state and regional environmental solutions.
- 5. The issues that the petitioner intends to raise in the proceeding will help the Commission determine whether the sale would benefit utility billpayers and serve the public interest, including the effect that the MidAmerican acquisition could have on the future of the PacifiCorp's resource planning and investment generally. More specifically, the petitioner intends to address the effect of the transaction on the company's commitment to and capacity to promote energy efficiency, renewable energy, grid enhancement and environmental remediation.
- 6. Petitioner has extensive knowledge and expertise that would assist the Commission in resolving the issues in this proceeding, including more than a quarter century of work with PacifiCorp on energy efficiency, renewable energy, resource planning and environmental issues. Petitioner's authorized representative, Ralph Cavanagh, has served since 2002 as a member of PacifiCorp's Environmental Forum, a regional body that advises the company on environmental strategies, challenges and priorities.
