3. Nature and extent of petitioner's interest in this proceeding:

Frontier is an incumbent rural local exchange carrier in Oregon and will therefore be directly affected by any decision that results from the investigation in this docket. This intervention is occurring now so that Frontier can participate as a separate party in this docket. Originally Frontier's interests were represented through its membership in the Oregon Telecommunications Association, which is already a party. However, Frontier has decided to withdraw from the association. Frontier must therefore now intervene separately in order to monitor and potentially participate in this proceeding.

4. The issues petitioner intends to raise at this proceeding:

Frontier will address issues that it deems relevant in this proceeding. Including those related to the determination of whether rural local exchange carriers should disaggregate Universal service support and if so, how that disaggregation should occur. Frontier's participation will not unreasonably broaden the issues or in any way unreasonably delay this proceeding.

5. Benefit of Frontier's intervention:

As an incumbent rural local exchange carrier in Oregon, Frontier has the knowledge and expertise that will assist the Commission and the parties in resolving this issues presented in this proceeding.

6. Absence of Objections to Frontier's Intervention:

On December 12, 2006, Ingo Henningsen of Frontier sent an E-mail to the other parties in this proceeding explaining that Frontier planned to intervene in the proceeding. Mr. Henningsen requested that the parties identify whether they objected to Frontier's intervention. As of the date of this filing, no party has objected to Frontier's intervention.

Frontier therefore requests that the Commission grant this Petition to Intervene.
