Pursuant to ORS § 756.525 and OAR § 860-012-0001, the Industrial Customers of Northwest Utilities (“ICNU”) petitions the Public Utility Commission of Oregon (“OPUC” or the “Commission”) to intervene in this proceeding with full party status as described in OAR § 860-011-0035(5). 3. ICNU is an incorporated, non-profit association of large industrial electric customers in the Pacific Northwest, with offices in Portland, Oregon. A list of ICNU members is included as Attachment A. Many of ICNU's members are customers of PacifiCorp and Portland General Electric Company ("PGE"), two investor-owned utilities that may be affected by any policies adopted in this proceeding.

4. ICNU has a substantial interest in the Commission's implementation of an automatic adjustment clause pursuant to Senate Bill ("SB") 838. Any Commission decision in this docket may directly impact the rates that ICNU's members pay for electric service.

5. ICNU's intervention in this proceeding will assist the Commission in resolving the issues and will not unreasonably broaden the issues, burden the record, or delay this proceeding.

6. As described above, ICNU has a direct and substantial interest in this proceeding that will not be adequately represented by any other party, and may be affected by any Commission determination made in connection with these proceedings. It is in the public interest to allow ICNU to intervene in this proceeding.

WHEREFORE, ICNU respectfully requests that the Commission grant its petition to intervene with full party status in this proceeding.
