NATURE AND EXTENT OF THE PETITIONER'S INTEREST IN THE PROCEEDING:

The Department has an interest in opportunities and barriers to integrating small-scale renewable energy resources under the Public Utilities Regulatory Policy Act. This interest is supported by the state's goal to encourage a diverse array of sustainable energy sources under ORS 469.010. In addition, ODOE is interested in UM 1725 because it raises issues related to UM 1610 (Investigation into Qualifying Facility Contracting and Pricing), to which ODOE is a party.

Under ORS 469.030, the department is statutorily charged with the responsibility to study, evaluate and disseminate information about energy use in Oregon. The department's responsibilities include the preparation of a comprehensive energy plan under ORS 460.060. As part of these responsibilities, under ORS 469.060, the department is charged with making "recommendations for state and local governments to assist in the development and maximum use of cost-effective conservation and renewable resources, consistent with the energy policy stated in ORS 469.010 * * *." (ORS 469.060(3)(f)). In aid of that responsibility, the department "may intervene in any proceeding undertaken by an agency for the purpose of expressing its views as to the effect of an agency action, upon state energy resources and state energy policy." ORS 469.110(2).
