Our mission is to provides a regional voice for the hydropower industry, representing the needs of membership since 1981. NWHA is dedicated to the "promotion of the region's waterpower as a clean, efficient energy resource while protecting the fisheries and environmental quality which characterize our Northwest region." 4. The nature and extent of the Petitioner's interest in the proceeding is:

NWHA promotes clean, renewable energy projects in the Northwest. We support the statute as enacted by the Oregon Legislature as a policy that can benefit members throughout the Northwest. Pumped storage hydro energy projects may be as small as 2 MWs and also substantially larger. The ability for these projects to support other renewable energy technologies as a stable integration tool and to provide additional benefits (water storage and conservation, timing of releases of water for instream and out of stream benefits and energy production, etc.) provides another tool in the energy storage protfolio both here in Oregon and throughout the Northwest.

5. The issues the Petitioner intends to raise at the proceeding are:

NWHA intends to participate as a party to raise issues as necessary and appropriate to the proceeding.

6. The special knowledge or expertise of the Petitioner that would assist the Commission in resolving the issues in the proceeding is:

NWHA has participated in rulemaking and legislation in the State of Oregon during its 35 year existence, working with agencies, such as the Oregon Water Resources Department and the Oregon Department of Energy to develop rules. The Association has also participated in storage dockets in other states. NWHA also participates in national forums regarding renewable energy policy.
