Amendment to the List of Available UNE to the Interconnection Agreement between Qwest Corporation and Oregon Telecom, Inc. for the State of Oregon

This is an Amendment ("Amendment") to the Interconnection Agreement between Qwest Corporation ("Qwest"), formerly known as USWEST Communications, Inc., a Colorado corporation, and Oregon Telecom, Inc. ("CLEC"). CLEC and Qwest shall be known jointly as the "Parties".

RECITALS

WHEREAS, CLEC and Qwest entered into an Interconnection Agreement (such Interconnection Agreement, as amended to date, being referred to herein as the "Agreement") for services in the state of Oregon which was approved by the Oregon Public Utility Commission ("Commission") on March 28, 2003, as referenced in Order No. 03-188; and

WHEREAS, the Parties wish to amend the Agreement by deleting the terms conditions, and rates associated with most Unbundled Network Elements ("UNEs"), including high capacity loops, dedicated transport, dark fiber as UNEs and UNE combinations including Enhanced Extended Links ("EELs"), as described herein so that the Agreement better reflects the products and services that CLEC orders and does not order or desire to order.

WHEREAS, the Parties wish to retain the terms, conditions and rates in the Agreement associated with DS0 capacity loops (2-wire analog/digital loops and 4-wire analog loops).

AGREEMENT

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual terms, covenants and conditions contained in this Amendment and other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged, the Parties agree as follows:

Amendment Terms

The Agreement is hereby amended by (a) deleting Sections 9.3 through 9.17 and 9.20 through 9.23 in their entirety, (b) deleting from Section 9.2 all references to any UNE other than DS0 capacity loops (2-wire analog/digital loops and 4-wire analog loops), including, without limitation, high capacity loops, dedicated transport, dark fiber and UNE combinations and (c) deleting the existing Exhibit A to the Agreement and replacing it with the Exhibit A attached to this Amendment.

If CLEC later desires to purchase other products and services, including any of those deleted from the Agreement with this Amendment that are then available, a new interconnection agreement will be required. If CLEC desires to order products and services affected by the Federal Communications Commission ("FCC")'s Report and Order *In the Matter of Review of the Section 251 Unbundling Obligations of Incumbent Local Exchange Carriers; Implementation of the Local Competition Provisions of the Telecommunications Act of 1996; Deployment of Wireline Services Offering Advanced Telecommunications Capability, CC Docket Nos. 01-338, 96-98 and 98-147 (effective October 2, 2003) ("TRO") or Review of the Section 251 Unbundling*

Obligations of Incumbent Local Exchange Carriers, Order on Remand (Triennial Review Remand Order) (FCC 04-290) ("TRRO") (effective March 11, 2005), the Parties will agree upon terms and conditions relating to the TRO and TRRO at that time.

Effective Date

This Amendment shall be deemed effective upon execution by authorized representatives of the Parties.

Amendments: Waivers

Except as modified herein, the provisions of the Agreement shall remain in full force and effect. The provisions of this Amendment, including the provisions of this sentence, may not be amended, modified or supplemented, and waivers or consents to departures from the provisions of this Amendment may not be given without the written consent thereto by both Parties' authorized representative. No waiver by any Party of any default, misrepresentation, or breach of warranty or covenant hereunder, whether intentional or not, will be deemed to extend to any prior or subsequent default, misrepresentation, or breach of warranty or covenant hereunder or affect in any way any rights arising by virtue of any prior or subsequent such occurrence.

Entire Agreement

The Agreement as amended (including the documents referred to herein) constitutes the full and entire understanding and agreement between the Parties with regard to the subjects of the Agreement as amended and supersedes any prior understandings, agreements, or representations by or between the Parties, written or oral, to the extent they relate in any way to the subjects of the Agreement as amended.
