### RE: Customer Request to Change Net Metering Billing

PGE submits the following information pursuant to OAR 860-039-0055, which states:

(2) Unless the public utility and the customer-generator otherwise agree, the annual billing cycle will end at the end of the March billing month of each year. Should the public utility and a customer-generator reach an agreement for a billing cycle ending other than at the end of the March billing month, the public utility must inform the Commission in writing of the alternative billing period within 30 calendar days of the agreement's execution.

We recently received a customer request for PGE to change their annual billing cycle from the cycle ending in March to the cycle ending in May. PGE intends to grant this request and is providing the required notification to the Commission with this letter. This request is in addition to eight previous requests by customers, all granted by PGE, to change the date of their annual billing cycle. PGE will now have a total of nine customers who have alternative billing periods.
