Re: UM 1514 Automated Demand Response - Interim Report

In accordance with the timeline PGE established for its Automated Demand Response pilot (ADR or Energy Partner) and the OPUC Staff's request for interim reporting, attached is PGE's interim report for the summer 2015 operating season. PGE's primary goal for the season was to continue to expand program participation, and call demand response events as appropriate. Highlights of ADR's fifth operating season include:

- Due to the warm weather, PGE was able to call four events during the summer 2015 season. The previous summer, enrolled customers achieved realization rates greater than 100%, indicating that they were under-nominating an achievable amount of load into the program. PGE and EnerNoc worked with customers to increase their nominated amounts, which led to realization rates below 100%. These realization rates were within planning targets and suggest customer nominations into the program have become more appropriate for pilot purposes.
- As of September 30, 2015, EnerNOC had signed contracts from 28 customers to participate in the pilot and achieved 9.1 MW of contracted capacity compared to 2.5 MW one year ago.
- PGE and EnerNOC continue to expand efforts to sign customers to the pilot and we estimate the winter 2016 capacity to be approximately 12 MW.
