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Idaho Power Company's Gateway West Transmission Updates for 4th Quarter 2014 January 15, 2015

In late 2013, Staff of the Public Utility Commission of Oregon ("OPUC"), requested that Idaho Power Company ("Idaho Power" or "Company") provide quarterly updates regarding the Energy Gateway West transmission project developed jointly between PacifiCorp and Idaho Power ("Companies"). Staff requested that, for <u>each</u> sub-segment² of this project, the Company provide a description of the developments³ that transpired in the previous quarter.

October – December, 2014:

The Bureau of Land Management ("BLM") held four open-house style public scoping meetings as part of the Supplemental Environmental Impact Statement ("SEIS") as follows:

The Companies attended the meetings, providing support to the BLM and interacting with members of the public, landowners, and local and state agency representatives. These meetings were very well attended with engaged and informed stakeholders. During the meetings, the Companies heard comments in support of the routes the Companies adopted from the BLM Boise District Resource Advisory Council. However, several stakeholders felt the Enhancement Package, which aligns with the enabling language and the Resource Management Plan of the Morley Nelson Snake River Birds of Prey ("SRBOP") in allowing transmission facilities to be located within the SRBOP, was not adequate to allow for the project

to be sited across the SRBOP National Conservation Area and needs to be adjusted. The public comment period closed on October 24, 2014. On December 15, 2014, the BLM provided their Scoping Report, which can be viewed at this website:

The schedule developed by the BLM has the following milestones:

- Publish the Notice of Intent to the Federal Register September 19, 2014 (this has occurred)
- Scoping period to end on October 24, 2014 (this has occurred)
- Draft SEIS scheduled to be available for a 90-day public comment period beginning in July 2015
- Final SEIS scheduled to be available for 30-day protest period June 2016
- Record of Decision ("ROD") scheduled to occur October 2016

The Companies continue to support the BLM to meet their next milestone, which is publishing the Draft SEIS to the Federal Register in early July 2015.

Because of sub-segments 8 and 9's importance to the Gateway West project and to Idaho Power's interest in the project, no additional permitting (state or local), regulatory activities, or other events are currently being pursued by Idaho Power until the BLM provides its ROD on these two sub-segments.
