- (2) The Directors hold office until the next annual meeting of shareholders, and until their successors shall have been elected and qualified, until death, resignation, or removal or until there is a decrease in the number of directors. Directors need not be residents of the State of Oregon or shareholders of the corporation, except as otherwise required by the board of Directors.
- (3) Annual salary assumes current salary plus 3.54% escalation.
- (4) Pension expense includes only current period service costs earned by employees.
- (5) Stock Purchase Plan consists of both performance and restricted stock grants estimated to vest in 2023.
- (6) This value represents compensation that officers have elected to defer into Non-Qualified Benefit Plans.
