**RE: 2017 Unused Energy Report for Net Metering Facilities in 2016**

As required by OAR 860-039-0060(3), PGE hereby submits this summary report detailing the total number of unused kilowatt-hour (kWh) credits accumulated by net metering customers at the close annual billing cycle, as well as the dollar value associated to these kWh credits to be transferred to low-income energy assistance.

At the end of the billing year that concluded in March 2017, the unused net metering kWh credits are 1,433,252 kWh with a dollar value of \$34,039.71 calculated at the average annual avoided cost rate valued at 2.375 cents/kWh.

As approved by the Commission, PGE will transfer the amount of \$34,039.71 to Oregon Heat for the benefit of low-income customers.
