#### **Political Advertising And Political Contributions**

\$ 130,000 has been budgeted as contributions to NW Natural's Political Action Committees. Specific expenditures for political advertising and political contributions have not been identified at this time.

#### Expenditures to organizations having an affiliated interest

1) Northwest Natural Gas Company pays KB Pipeline Company a monthly commitment fee plus a commodity charge if used, related to KB Pipeline. NNG Financial Corporation owns 100% of KB Pipeline Company. KB Pipeline Company owns an undivided 10% interest of Kelso Beaver Pipeline assets. Portland General Electric Company owns 79.5% of the remaining 90% and BR Pipeline owns 10.5% of the remaining 90%.
