#### Expenditures to organizations having an affiliated interest

Northwest Natural Gas Company pays KB Pipeline Company a monthly commitment fee plus a commodity charge if used, related to KB Pipeline. NNG Financial Corporation owns 100% of KB Pipeline Company. KB Pipeline Company owns an undivided 10% interest of Kelso Beaver Pipeline assets. Portland General Electric Company owns 79.5% of the remaining 90% and BR Pipeline owns 10.5% of the remaining 90%.
