Dear Secretary Bose:

Pursuant to Section 205 of the Federal Power Act, 16 U.S.C. § 824d (2012), Part 35 of the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission's ("FERC" or the "Commission") regulations, 18 C.F.R. Part 35 (2018), and Order No. 714<sup>1</sup> regarding electronic filing of tariff submittals, PacifiCorp hereby notifies the Commission that it is terminating PacifiCorp Rate Schedule No. 726, a Project Construction Agreement ("Construction Agreement") between International Paper Company ("International Paper") and PacifiCorp.

## 1. Background and Reason for Filing

On January 30, 2017, International Paper and PacifiCorp entered into the Construction Agreement. The Construction Agreement set forth the associated terms and conditions of work to be performed in order to accommodate International Paper's request for the termination and removal of the interconnection(s) between the parties at or near the Western Kraft substation. On February 13, 2017, PacifiCorp filed the Construction Agreement as Rate Schedule No. 726, in docket no. ER17-966. The Commission accepted the filing on March 30, 2017, effective April 15, 2017, via letter order.<sup>2</sup>

Section 2 (Term & Termination) of the Construction Agreement states, in relevant part, that the Construction Agreement "shall terminate ninety (90) days following: (i) Company's receipt of final payment of actual costs by Customer." On November 27, 2018 PacifiCorp received final payment from International Paper. Accordingly, PacifiCorp now seeks to terminate the Construction agreement pursuant to its own terms.

## 2. Effective Date

In accordance with 18 C.F.R. § 35.15(a) of the Commission's regulations, PacifiCorp respectfully requests that the termination become effective February 25, 2019, which will be 90 days after final payment.
