Dear Secretary Bose:

Pursuant to Section 205 of the Federal Power Act, 16 U.S.C. § 824d (2012), Part 35 of the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission’s (“Commission”) regulations, 18 C.F.R. Part 35 (2018), and Order No. 714<sup>1</sup> regarding electronic filing of tariff submittals, PacifiCorp hereby notifies the Commission that it is terminating PacifiCorp Service Agreement No. 893 under PacifiCorp’s Volume No. 11 Open Access Transmission Tariff (“OATT”), an Engineering and Procurement Agreement (“E&P Agreement”) between PacifiCorp and Obsidian Renewables, LLC (“Obsidian”). PacifiCorp respectfully requests an effective date for this termination of December 16, 2018, for the reasons described below.

## **1. Background and Reason for Filing**

On June 21, 2018, PacifiCorp and Obsidian entered into the E&P Agreement. The E&P Agreement provided the terms and conditions under which PacifiCorp was authorized to begin to design, engineer, and procure items necessary to advance the implementation of the interconnection of Obsidian’s facilities. On July 10, 2018, PacifiCorp filed the E&P Agreement with the Commission, in Docket No. ER18-1988. The Commission accepted the filing on August 20, 2018, via letter order, effective June 21, 2018.<sup>2</sup>

Section 2 (Effective Date, Term and Termination) of the E&P Agreement states, in relevant part, that the E&P Agreement “...shall remain in effect until 90 days after... execution by the Parties of the SGIA [Small Generator Interconnection Agreement].” On September 17, 2018, Obsidian and PacifiCorp executed the SGIA.<sup>3</sup> Accordingly, PacifiCorp now seeks to terminate the E&P Agreement pursuant to the agreement’s own terms.

PacifiCorp has provided notice of filing to the lone affected party, Obsidian.
