Notice of Termination

Dear Secretary Bose:

Pursuant to section 205 of the Federal Power Act ("FPA"), 16 U.S.C. § 824d, and Section 35.15 of the Regulations of the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission ("Commission"), 18 C.F.R. § 35.15, and Order No. 714¹ regarding electronic filing of tariff submittals, PacifiCorp hereby notifies the Commission that it is terminating PacifiCorp Rate Schedule No. 748, a Project Construction Agreement ("Agreement") between Bonneville Power Administration ("BPA") and PacifiCorp.

1. Background and Reason for Filing

On October 3, 2019, PacifiCorp and BPA entered into the Agreement. BPA requested that a 18.2 megawatt ("MW") Green Springs Generation Facility owned by the Bureau of Reclamation be moved from the BPA-operated Balancing Authority Area ("BAA") into PacifiCorp's BAA. BPA requested PacifiCorp perform certain work to accommodate the request. The Agreement set forth the design, installation and construction work to be performed by BPA and PacifiCorp to accommodate BPA's request. On October 17, 2019, PacifiCorp filed the Agreement with the Commission, in Docket No. ER20-133. The Agreement was designated as PacifiCorp Rate Schedule No. 748. The Commission accepted the filing on December 6, 2019, via letter order, effective December 17, 2019.

Section 2 (Term) of the agreement states, in relevant part, that the Agreement "...shall terminate ninety (90) days following: Company's receipt of final payment from BPA. On December 15, 2021 PacifiCorp issued a final accounting letter with no balance due. Accordingly, PacifiCorp now seeks to terminate the Agreement.

2. Effective Date

In accordance with 18 C.F.R. § 35.15(a) of the Commission's regulations, PacifiCorp respectfully requests that the termination become effective March 15, 2022. March 15, 2022 is ninety (90) days from date PacifiCorp issued refund.

PacifiCorp has provided notice of filing to the lone affected party, BPA.
