Dear Mr. Woodworth:

On February 21, 2018, PacifiCorp submitted a Project Construction Agreement (Agreement) between Portland General Electric Company (PGE) and PacifiCorp.¹ PacifiCorp states that the Agreement sets forth the terms and conditions under which PacifiCorp agrees to perform and PGE agrees to pay for certain work to accommodate PGE's transmission construction plans. The Agreement is accepted for filing, effective April 23, 2018, as requested.

The filing was noticed on February 21, 2018, with comments, protests, or interventions due on or before March 14, 2018. No protests or adverse comments were filed. Notices of intervention and unopposed timely filed motions to intervene are granted pursuant to the operation of Rule 214 of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure (18 C.F.R. § 385.214). Any opposed or untimely filed motion to intervene is governed by the provisions of Rule 214.

This action does not constitute approval of any service, rate, charge, classification, or any rule, regulation, contract, or practice affecting such rate or service provided for in the filed documents; nor shall such action be deemed as recognition of any claimed

contractual right or obligation affecting or relating to such service or rate; and such action is without prejudice to any findings or orders which have been or may hereafter be made by the Commission in any proceeding now pending or hereafter instituted by or against PacifiCorp.

This action is taken pursuant to authority delegated to the Director, Division of Electric Power Regulation - West, under 18 C.F.R. § 375.307. This order constitutes final agency action. Requests for rehearing by the Commission may be filed within 30 days of the date of issuance of this order, pursuant to 18 C.F.R. § 385.713.
