On December 14, 2018, PacifiCorp filed revisions to Attachment M of its open access transmission tariff (OATT) to address newly adopted regulations by the Public Utility Commission of Oregon regarding retail access pursuant to the Oregon Direct Access program, to clarify certain process and requirements for Oregon Direct Access customers, and to align the Oregon Direct Access monthly charge with existing rates in PacifiCorp's OATT. PacifiCorp's revisions are accepted for filing, effective February 14, 2019, as requested.

The filing was noticed on December 17, 2018, with comments, protests, or interventions due on or before January 4, 2019. No protests or adverse comments were filed. Notices of intervention and unopposed timely filed motions to intervene are granted pursuant to the operation of Rule 214 of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure (18 C.F.R. § 385.214). Any opposed or untimely filed motion to intervene is governed by the provisions of Rule 214.

This action does not constitute approval of any service, rate, charge, classification, or any rule, regulation, contract, or practice affecting such rate or service provided for in the filed documents; nor shall such action be deemed as recognition of any claimed contractual right or obligation affecting or relating to such service or rate; and such action is without prejudice to any findings or orders which have been or may hereafter be made by the Commission in any proceeding now pending or hereafter instituted by or against PacifiCorp.

This action is taken pursuant to authority delegated to the Director, Division of Electric Power Regulation - West, under 18 C.F.R. § 375.307. This order constitutes final agency action. Requests for rehearing by the Commission may be filed within 30

days of the date of issuance of this order, pursuant to 18 C.F.R. § 385.713.
