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Reference: Network Integration Transmission Service Agreement

On March 6, 2019, PacifiCorp filed a Network Integration Transmission Service Agreement (NITSA) between PacifiCorp and Bonneville Power Administration (Bonneville). PacifiCorp states that the NITSA sets the terms by which PacifiCorp will provide network integration transmission service to Bonneville's load with delivery to Bonneville's customer, Surprise Valley Electrification Corporation.¹ The NITSA is accepted for filing, effective March 29, 2019, as requested.

The filing was noticed on March 6, 2019, with comments, protests, or interventions due on or before March 27, 2019. No protests or adverse comments were filed. Notices of intervention and unopposed timely filed motions to intervene are granted pursuant to the operation of Rule 214 of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure (18 C.F.R. § 385.214). Any opposed or untimely filed motion to intervene is governed by the provisions of Rule 214.

This action does not constitute approval of any service, rate, charge, classification, or any rule, regulation, contract, or practice affecting such rate or service provided for in the filed documents; nor shall such action be deemed as recognition of any claimed contractual right or obligation affecting or relating to such service or rate; and such action is without prejudice to any findings or orders which have been or may hereafter be made by the Commission in any proceeding now pending or hereafter instituted by or against PacifiCorp.
