Dear Secretary Bose:

Pursuant to Section 205 of the Federal Power Act, 16 U.S.C. § 824d (2012), Part 35 of the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission's ("Commission") regulations, 18 C.F.R. Part 35 (2018), and Order No. 714¹ regarding electronic filing of tariff submittals, PacifiCorp hereby notifies the Commission that it is terminating PacifiCorp Service Agreement No. 914 between PacifiCorp and Invenegy Solar Development North America, LLC ("Invenegy") entered into on November 19, 2018 ("E&P Agreement"). The E&P Agreement was entered into pursuant to PacifiCorp's Volume No. 11 Open Access Transmission Tariff ("OATT"). PacifiCorp respectfully requests an effective date for the termination of the E&P Agreement of July 29, 2019, for the reasons described below.

1. Background and Reason for Filing

On November 19, 2018, PacifiCorp and Invenegy entered into the E&P Agreement under which PacifiCorp was to begin to design, engineer, and procure interconnection facilities necessary for the interconnection of Invenegy Solar Development North America, LLC's proposed Large Generating Facility.

On December 6, 2018, PacifiCorp filed the E&P Agreement with the Commission, in Docket No. ER19-499. The E&P Agreement was designated as PacifiCorp Service Agreement No. 914. The Commission accepted the filing on January 23, 2019, via letter order² effective November 19, 2018.

Sections 2 through 2(a) of the E&P Agreement (Effective Date, Term and Termination) state, in relevant part, that the E&P Agreement "shall remain in effect until 90 days after... (a) Execution by the parties of the Large Generator Interconnection Agreement for the project ("LGIA")." On April 30, 2019 PacifiCorp fully executed an LGIA for this Large Generating

Facility pursuant to the terms of the OATT, triggering termination of the E&P Agreement under Section 2(a) of the E&P Agreement.

Accordingly, PacifiCorp now seeks to terminate the E&P Agreement pursuant to the agreement's own terms.

2. Effective Date

In accordance with the terms of the E&P Agreement, PacifiCorp respectfully requests that the termination become effective July 29, 2019. This notice is provided in compliance with 18 C.F.R. § 35.15(a) of the Commission's regulations, which requires sixty (60) days' notice prior to termination of a rate schedule, tariff, or service agreement by its own terms.

PacifiCorp has provided notice of this filing to Invenergy.
