21	Company), hereby files with the Public Utility Commission of Oregon (Commission) this				
22	application for reauthorization (Application) to use deferred accounting pursuant to ORS				
23	727.210 and 757.259, and OAR 860-027-0300, for the 12-month period beginning				
24	January 26, 2010 through January 25, 2011.				
25	In compliance with the requirements of OAR 860-027-0300(3) and (4), NW				
26	Natural hereby submits the following information:				
27	1. A description of the utility expenses or revenues for which deferred				
28	accounting is requested. [OAR 860-027-0300 (3)(a)]:				
29	NW Natural seeks authorization to record all environmental costs, which				
30	shall include, but are not necessarily limited to, all costs related to investigation, study,				
31	monitoring, oversight, legal and remediation costs, and all costs associated with				
32	pursuing insurance recoveries (hereafter "Environmental Costs") that are associated				

with the nine projects: eight were described in more detail in the Company's initial
 Application for Authorization to Defer Accounting, filed April 7, 2003; the ninth project
 designated as the French American International School (FAIS), was described in the
 Company's Application for Reauthorization to Defer Accounting, filed on January 25,
 2008.

Justification for the deferred accounting requested with reference to
 the sections of ORS 757.259 under which deferral can be authorized. [OAR 860 027-0300 (3)(b)]:

9 Authorization to defer Environmental Costs and amounts from insurance 10 recoveries can be authorized pursuant to ORS 757.259(2)(d) because they are "utility 11 expenses or revenues, the recovery or refund of which the commission finds should be 12 deferred in order to minimize the frequency of rate changes ... or to match appropriately 13 the costs borne by and benefits received by ratepayers."

3. The accounts proposed for recording the amounts to be deferred
 and the accounts that would be used for recording the amounts in the absence of
 approval of deferred accounting are as follows. [OAR 860-027-0300 (3)(c)]:

NW Natural proposes to accrue estimates of the Environmental Costs to a

220 N.W. Second Avenue Portland, Oregon 97209-3991 1 general rate case filing, in compliance with the Commission's Order No. 06-211, dated 2 April 27, 2006, in this matter. As the nine sites are at different study and remediation 3 stages, NW Natural may present to the Commission a proposed ratemaking treatment 4 for deferred costs associated with a particular site, should costs and remediation at the 5 particular site become known and certain. At the time of consideration for incorporation 6 into rates, NW Natural will propose an appropriate amortization period for the 7 Environmental Costs for the Commission's consideration. NW Natural does not request 8 a determination of ratemaking treatment of the Environmental Costs at this time.

9 4. An estimate of the amount to be recorded in the deferred accounts 10 for the 12-month period subsequent to the Application. [OAR 860-027-0300 11 (3)(d)]:

12 The Company will incur additional site study, clean-up, potential natural 13 resource damages, DEQ/Environment Protection Agency, tribe and natural resource 14 damage trustee oversight, and legal costs as well as administrative expenses related to 15 feasibility studies and remediation activities associated with these sites. Environmental 16 Costs will be charged to deferred regulatory asset accounts. Insurance recoveries will 17 be used as offsets to deferred Environmental Costs. These anticipated expenses and 18 recoveries from insurance are the cause of this filing. At this time, information is 19 insufficient to more accurately estimate the total potential liability for investigation and 20 remediation costs associated with the nine sites, or to accurately estimate the 21 corresponding total insurance recovery amounts.

6. Interest on Deferred Balances. [OAR 860-027-0300(4)(b)]:

4 As part of this reauthorization, the Company requests for continued permission to 5 accrue interest to the deferred actual cash expenses. The Commission has allowed the 6 Company to collect interest on deferred balances as stated in Commission Order Nos. 7 06-211, 07-147, 08-247, and 09-172. As of 2009, the Company has spent over \$46 8 million on projects. As those amounts continue to be outstanding in anticipation of 9 insurance offsets or recovery from ratepayers, financing the spent amounts is an 10 ongoing burden. As insurance proceeds are attained, they will be used to draw down 11 the amounts outstanding, until final ratemaking is determined for the deferred accounts 12 and interest on the balance would be affected accordingly. Please note, that the 13 Company does not accrue interest on the recorded liability. 14 7. Reason for the continued request to defer accounting. [OAR 860-15 027-0300(4)(b)]:

Since early 2006, NW Natural has been pursuing recovery of insurance for its
environmental liabilities. It has identified and analyzed all of the liability insurance

1 policies issued between the late 1930s and 1986 which may provide coverage. All of 2 the insurers have been contacted. Most have signed confidentiality agreements and 3 have been provided detailed information about the environmental liabilities. Because 4 the coverage issues involve complex legal and factual issues, the insurers have not 5 agreed that coverage exists. However, most have agreed to enter into negotiations in 6 an effort to resolve the claims. Given the complexity of the claims, negotiations are 7 expected to be lengthy. NW Natural will pursue litigation against any of the insurers with 8 which it is unable to reach settlements within a reasonable period of time. 9 8. A notice of this Application has been served on the UM 1078 service list 10 and on all parties who participated in the Company's most recent general rate case.
