APPLICATION FOR REAUTHORIZATION OF DEFERRED ACCOUNTING

Under ORS 757.259 and OAR 860-027-0300, PacifiCorp, d/b/a Pacific Power, files this application (Application) with the Public Utility Commission of Oregon (Commission) for an order reauthorizing PacifiCorp to record and defer, on an ongoing basis, the cost of intervenor funding grants under ORS 757.259(3). PacifiCorp respectfully requests reauthorization for a 12-month period commencing August 1, 2020.

In support of this Application, and in accordance with OAR 860-027-0300(3) and (4), PacifiCorp states:

#### A. PacifiCorp

PacifiCorp is a public utility in the state of Oregon and is subject to the jurisdiction of the Commission with regard to rates, service, and accounting practices. PacifiCorp also provides retail electricity service in the states of California, Idaho, Utah, Washington, and Wyoming.

#### **B.** Statutory Authority

This Application is filed in accordance with ORS 757.259, which authorizes the deferral of expenses or revenues of a public utility for later incorporation in rates. ORS 757.259(3) allows for deferral of amounts provided in accordance with a financial assistance agreement entered into under ORS 757.072.

#### **D.** Basis for Application

#### 1. Statutory Authority

ORS 757.072 authorizes the Commission to approve an agreement between an energy utility and a customer organization for intervenor funding. ORS 757.259(3) allows a utility to recover intervenor funding in rates through deferred accounting:

Upon request of the public utility, the commission by order shall allow deferral of amounts provided as financial assistance under an agreement entered into under ORS 757.072 for later incorporation in rates.

Deferred amounts under ORS 757.259(3) are not subject to the percentage of gross revenues limitation on amortization or other provisions of subsections (5), (6), (7), and (8) of ORS 757.259.

# 2. Commission Approval of the Intervenor Funding Agreement and the Multi-State Process Intervenor Funding Agreement

On July 2, 2003, per section 2 of the Intervenor Funding Act, the Commission issued Order No. 03-388 in docket AR 462, which, among other things, approved the Intervenor Funding Agreement among PacifiCorp, Portland General Electric Company, Northwest Natural Gas Company, Northwest Industrial Gas Users, Oregon Citizens' Utility Board (CUB), and Industrial Customers of Northwest Utilities (ICNU), dated February 5, 2003. On December 19, 2007, the Commission issued Order No. 07-564 in docket UM 1357 approving the Amended and Restated Intervenor Funding Agreement that extended intervenor funding until December 31, 2012. On November 20, 2012, the Commission issued Order No. 12-452 in docket UM 1357 approving the Second Amended and Restated Intervenor Funding Agreement that extended intervenor funding until December 31, 2017. The Intervenor Funding Agreement sets forth the amount of funding to be contributed by each utility and the procedures for budget submittals by intervenors, Commission approval of budgets, and the payment of grants by utilities. Additionally, the Intervenor Funding Agreement allows intervenors to request grants at any time during the calendar year. On October 20, 2016, the Commission issued Order No. 15-335 in docket UM 1357 approving the Third Amended and Restated Intervenor Funding Agreement that increased funding levels for certain Commission proceedings related to Northwest Natural Gas Company and Avista Corporation. On January 17, 2018, the Commission issued Order No. 18-017 in docket UM 1929 approving the Fourth Amended and Restated Intervenor Agreement that continues the three funds from

which intervenor funding grants can be made and modified the amounts in each fund as reflected in the table below.

The agreement also makes changes regarding the Preauthorized Matching Funds and Issue Funds. The agreement allows the Alliance of Western Energy Consumers (AWEC)<sup>1</sup> to request payment of Preauthorized Matching Grants semi-annually, rather than annually, and lowers the matching amount of internal resources or outside funding from 50 percent to 35 percent. With regard to Issue Funds, the agreement amends the definition of "eligible proceedings." To help ease administrative efficiency, the agreement restricts eligible proceedings to significant proceedings, including general rate cases, mergers and acquisitions, integrated resource plans, annual power cost updates, and others so designated by the Commission.

In 2012, the Commission issued Order Nos. 12-110 and 12-122 in docket UM 1586 approving the Multi-State Process Intervenor Funding Agreement (MSP Funding Agreement) between PacifiCorp, CUB, and ICNU. This agreement provides funding for CUB's and ICNU's participation in ongoing efforts to address how system costs are apportioned among PacifiCorp's six-state territory. On February 7, 2017, the Commission issued Order No. 17-028 in docket UM 1586 approving the amended and restated MSP Funding Agreement that extended the intervenor funding until December 31, 2018. On January 16, 2019, the Commission issued Order No. 19-013 in docket UM 1586, approving the Third Amended

and Restated Intervenor Funding Agreement. On June 16, 2020, the Commission issued Order No. 20-189 in docket UM 1586, approving the Multi-State Process Fourth Amended and Restated Intervenor Funding Agreement. The MSP funding agreement provides the amount of funding to be provided (the amounts are reflected in the table below) and procedures for budgets, approvals and payment of intervener funding grants that that can be made.

#### E. Request for Reauthorization of Deferred Accounting

Under the instant docket, the Commission issued a series of orders authorizing PacifiCorp's deferral of Intervenor Funding Agreement costs. The Commission originally authorized deferral of the Intervenor Funding Agreement costs beginning September 17, 2003, in Order No. 03-560. The Commission reauthorized this deferral annually, most recently in Order No. 18-315, which reauthorized the deferral through July 31, 2019. On July 31, 2019, PacifiCorp filed for reauthorization of the deferral of Intervenor Funding Agreement costs for a 12-month period commencing August 1, 2019. The Commission has not yet taken action on PacifiCorp's July 31, 2019 deferral; without presupposing the Commission's decision related to PacifiCorp's July 31, 2019 filing, PacifiCorp seeks reauthorization of this deferral for a 12-month period beginning August 1, 2020.

#### H. Description and Explanation of Entries in the Deferred Account to Date

Attachment B provides the most recent entries in the deferred account to date of the Application. These entries are for amounts paid to intervenors as ordered by the Commission per the Intervenor Funding Agreement adopted by Order No. 18-017 and the MSP Funding Agreement adopted by Order No. 19-013.

#### I. Reasons for Continuation of Deferred Accounting

PacifiCorp requests the continuation of deferred accounting in order to seek future recovery of amounts previously approved in this docket.

#### J. Use of Sub-accounts

Ordering paragraph 2 of Order No. 10-323, docket UM 1102, requires PacifiCorp to

separately account for each type of grant. Section 4.2 of the MSP Funding Agreement also requires PacifiCorp to separately account for each type of MSP Funding grant. PacifiCorp tracks intervenor funding grants by grant type through different internal order numbers.

Issue fund grant amounts paid to AWEC are tracked through internal order number 313374. Issue fund grant amounts paid to CUB are tracked through internal order number 313431. Matching fund grant amounts paid to AWEC are tracked through internal order number 313430. Matching fund grant amounts paid to CUB are tracked through internal order number 313429. MSP fund grant amounts paid to CUB and AWEC are tracked through internal order numbers 339031 and 339032, respectively.

#### K. Notice

A copy of the Notice of the Application of PacifiCorp for Reauthorization of Deferred Accounting Regarding Intervenor Funding Grants is included with this Application as Attachment A. This notice will be served to the service list from the company's most recent general rate case.

WHEREFORE, PacifiCorp respectfully requests that in accordance with ORS 757.259(3), the Commission reauthorize PacifiCorp to record and defer, on an ongoing basis and commencing as of August 1, 2020, Intervenor Funding Grants incurred by the company per the Intervenor Funding Agreement and the MSP Funding Agreement, as described in this Application.
