INTRODUCTION

I.

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PACIFICORP'S APPLICATION FOR REAUTHORIZATION OF DEFERRED ACCOUNTING

2 On January 22, 2008, pursuant to ORS 757.259 and OAR 860-027-0300, PacifiCorp, 3 d.b.a. Pacific Power ("Company") applied to the Public Utility Commission of Oregon 4 ("Commission") for an order authorizing the Company to defer the costs associated with the 5 Oregon independent evaluators ("IEs") selected and approved by the Commission for the 6 Company's 2008 All Source Request for Proposal ("All Source RFP") in Docket UM 1360. In Order No. 08-119, the Commission approved the Company's application for deferred 7 8 accounting. The Company filed an application requesting reauthorization to defer costs 9 associated with the IE on January 22, 2009, which was approved by the Commission in 10 Order No. 09-071. The All Source RFP process is ongoing, therefore the Company is submitting this application ("Application") for an order reauthorizing the Company to defer 11 12 costs associated with the IE. 13 In support of this Application, the Company states as follows: 14 II. DEFERRED ACCOUNTING RULE REQUIREMENTS 11 The following is provided pursuant to the requirements set forth in OAR 860-027-12 0300(3). 13 A. **Description of Utility Expense.** 14 On August 10, 2006, the Commission issued competitive bidding requirements for 15 new supply-side resource acquisitions applicable to Oregon's investor-owned utilities. See Order No. 06-446 ("RFP Order"). Guideline 5 of the RFP Order requires an IE's 16 17 participation in all RFPs. Guideline 5 also provides that a utility may request deferred 18 accounting to track the costs of an IE for later inclusion in rates. 19 On January 16, 2008, the Commission entered Order No. 08-019, which opened 20 Docket UM 1360 to address the Company's All Source RFP. Order No. 08-019 also directed 21 the Company to negotiate a contract with Boston Pacific Company, Inc. and Accion Group 22 for independent evaluator services regarding the All Source RFP. Pursuant to that directive,

- the Company entered into professional service contracts with the IEs on February 27, 2008
- 2 ("IE Contracts"). On October 2, 2008, PacifiCorp issued the All Source RFP to market and
- 3 received bidders' proposals on December 16, 2008.
- 4 On February 15, 2008, the Commission granted the Company's request to defer costs
- 5 associated with the IEs' services in Order No. 08-119 ("First 2008 RFP IE Deferred
- 6 Accounting Order"). The Company filed an application requesting reauthorization to defer
- 7 costs associated with the IE on January 22, 2009, which was approved by the Commission in
- 8 Order No. 09-071 ("Second 2008 RFP IE Deferred Accounting Order").
- 9 On February 27, 2009, the Company filed a Notice of Suspension of 2008 All Source
- Request for Proposal, indicating the Company had determined it was not in the best interests
- of customers to proceed with the All Source RFP in light of changes in economic and market
- 12 conditions. On November 2, 2009, the Company requested approval to resume and re-issue
- the All Source RFP, which was granted by the Commission in Order No. 09-491 (December
- 14 14, 2009).
- The IEs continue to perform services under the IE Contracts and will continue to do
- so until the conclusion of the All Source RFP. Because a deferral period may not exceed
- twelve months beginning on or after the date of application, the Company seeks an order
- reauthorizing the Company to continue to defer costs from the date of this Application
- 19 forward. See ORS 757.259(4).

20 B. Reasons for Deferral.

- ORS 757.259(2)(e) allows the deferral of utility expenses or revenues where
- 22 necessary to match appropriately the costs borne by and benefits received by customers.
- 23 This request seeks to align the costs of the IEs and the services they will perform on behalf of

- the Company's customers. In its RFP Order, the Commission specifically approved the use
- 2 of deferred accounting to match the customer costs and benefits of an IE in this manner.
- 3 C. Proposed Accounting.
- 4 During the period of deferral, the Company proposes to account for the deferred costs
- of the IEs by recording the deferral in Account 182.3, Other Regulatory Assets. This
- 6 proposal is consistent with the Company's current deferral accounting practices under the
- 7 First 2008 RFP IE Deferred Accounting Order and Second 2008 IE Deferred Accounting
- 8 Order.
- 9 D. Estimate of Amounts.
- 10 As of the date of this Application, the Company has paid the IEs approximately
- \$380,000 for the IEs' services. The Company anticipates that the total cost of the IEs will be
- 12 approximately \$700,000.
- 13 E. Notice.
- A copy of the Notice of Application and a list of the persons served with the Notice
- were attached to the original Application as Exhibit A.
- 16 IV. CONCLUSION
- 17 The Company respectfully requests that, in accordance with ORS 757.259, the
- 18 Commission reauthorize the Company to defer the costs described in this Application.
