9		I. INTROD	UCTION
10	Pursuant to ORS 757.210, ORS 757.259, and OAR 860-027-0300, Idaho Power		
11	Company ("Idaho Power") hereby requests an accounting order authorizing Idaho Power to		
12	defer for later ratemaking treatment annual net variable power cost variances pursuant to		
13	Order No. 08-238 and Idaho Power Tariff Schedule 56. Schedule 56 is an "automatic		
14	adjustment clause" as defined in ORS 757.210. Idaho Power seeks authorization for this		
15	deferral effective as of January 1, 2012. In support of this Application, Idaho Power states:		
16	1.	Idaho Power is a public utility in th	ne state of Oregon and its rates, services
17	and accounting practices are subject to the regulation of the Public Utility		
18		Commission of Oregon ("Commissi	on").
19	2.	This Application is filed pursuar	nt to ORS 757.259, which allows the
20		Commission, upon application, to a	authorize deferral of certain items for later
21		inclusion in rates.

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7	II. OAR 860-027-0300 Requirements		
8	The following is provided pursuant to OAR 860-027-0300(3):		
9	A. <u>Description</u>		
10	With this deferral application, Idaho Power seeks authorization from the Commission		
11	to accrue, for future amortization, the difference between actual annual net variable power		
12	costs and the annual net variable power costs forecasted pursuant to Tariff Schedule 55, in		
13	accordance with Order No. 08-238. The annual variance will be determined pursuant to the		
14	terms of Schedule 56, which includes a Power Supply Expense Deadband and an Earnings		
15	Test.		
16	B. <u>Reasons for Deferral</u>		
17	In Order No. 08-238, the Commission ordered the adoption of a power cost		
18	adjustment mechanism for Idaho Power that contains both an Annual Power Cost Update		
19	("APCU") and Power Cost Adjustment Mechanism ("PCAM"). Idaho Power Schedule 55		
20	contains the terms of the APCU while Schedule 56 contains the terms of the PCAM. The		
21	PCAM provides for recognition in rates of the difference, for a given year, between the		
22	actual annual net variable power costs incurred by Idaho Power and the net annual variable		
23	power costs forecasted pursuant to Idaho Power Schedule 55. This deferral is intended to		
24	capture the net annual variable power cost difference that will be amortized in rates.		
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1 This deferral is filed pursuant to Order No. 08-238 and ORS 757.259(2)(e). This 2 deferral will minimize the frequency of rate changes or the fluctuation of rate levels or match 3 appropriately the costs borne by and benefits received by customers.

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C. <u>Proposed Accounting</u>

5 Idaho Power proposes to record the Deferred Amount in FERC Account 182.3 6 (Regulatory Assets); crediting FERC Account 557(Other Expenses) if there is an amount to 7 collect from customers. Idaho Power would record the Accrued Amount in FERC 254 8 (Regulatory Liabilities); debiting FERC Account 557(Other Expenses) if there is a refund to 9 customers. In the absence of a deferred accounting order from the Commission, Idaho 10 Power would record costs associated with the Deferred Amount to FERC 501 (Fuel), FERC 11 547 (Fuel), FERC 447 (Sales for Resale), FERC 565 (Transmission by Others) and FERC 12 555 (Purchased Power).

D. Estimate of Amounts

The Deferred Amount is a function of several unknown and unpredictable factors including customer usage, the wholesale market price for electricity, and the wholesale market price for natural gas. Because the Deferred Amount is dependent on factors that cannot be precisely forecast, Idaho Power cannot provide a precise estimate of the Deferred Amount. Idaho Power requests that, in accordance with Order No. 05-1070, it be allowed to accrue interest on the unamortized balance at a rate equal to its authorized weighted average cost of capital most recently approved by the Commission.

25 Deferred accounting treatment is an appropriate, just, and reasonable means of 26 implementing Order No. 08-238 and Idaho Power Schedule 56.
