12	requests to defer the difference between the annual fee amounts that are currently
13	being collected through rates and the increased annual fee.
14	E. Reasons Reauthorization of Deferred Accounting is Being Requested –
15	OAR 860-027-0300(3)(b).
16	ORS 757.259(2)(e) allows the deferral of utility expenses where necessary to
17	minimize the frequency of rate changes or the fluctuation of rate levels or to match
18	appropriately the costs borne by and benefits received by ratepayers. The Company
19	requests deferral of the costs associated with the incremental increase of the
20	regulatory fee. NW Natural does not seek to defer the costs associated with the
21	annual fee that have already been included in rates, and only seeks to defer the
22	incremental costs until such time as any increased fee amount can be included in
23	NW Natural's established rates. While the amounts deferred may not be significant,
24	NW Natural seeks this reauthorization because the 2022 increase to the annual fee
25	was not a regularly scheduled event, which makes planning for any fee increase
