20	I. INTRODUCTION		
21	Pursuant to OAR 860-021-0034, the Co	mpany must pay the Commission a	
22	fee on gross operating revenues. At the time of	f the Company's last general rate	
23	case, the regulatory fee was 0.25 percent. On	February 23, 2016, the	
24	Commission issued Order No. 16-067, increas	ing the annual fee rate from 0.25	
25	percent to 0.275 percent. The Company filed	an application to defer expenses	
26	related to the increase in the regulatory fee on	March 23, 2016. The Commission	
27	approved the Company's deferral request in O	rder No. 16-154. Applicable	
28	temporaries included in the 2016-17 purchase	gas adjustment (PGA) included the	

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0.275 percent regulatory fee, including the deferral that represented the 0.025
 difference between the amount for the annual fee that was included in the
 Company's last general rate case and the newly established fee in March 2016.

On February 22, 2017, in Commission Order No. 17-065, the Commission
increased the fee from 0.275 percent to 0.3 percent. As a result of the increase,
NW Natural requests in this reauthorization to continue deferring the amount for
annual fees not captured in our last general rate case, and increasing that amount
by .025 percent, representing the increase approved by the Commission in Order
No. 17-065.

II. DEFERRED ACCOUNTING RULE REQUIREMENTS

11 The following information is provided pursuant to the requirements set 12 forth in OAR 860-027-0300(3) and (4), and Commission Order No. 09-263.

13 A. Description of Utility Expense – OAR 860-27-0300(3)(a)

In this Application, the Company is requesting to defer the costs that
represent the difference in the regulatory fee currently embedded in rates and the
new regulatory fee established in Order No. 17-065. Specifically, NW Natural
requests to defer 0.05 percent of the 0.3 percent annual fee that is not currently
captured in rates.

19 B. Reasons for Deferral – OAR 860-027-0300(3)(b)

ORS 757.259(2)(e) allows the deferral of utility expenses where necessary to minimize the frequency of rate changes or the fluctuation of rate levels or to match appropriately the costs borne by and benefits received by ratepayers. The Company requests deferral of the costs associated with the incremental increase

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1 of the regulatory fee. NW Natural does not seek to defer the costs associated 2 with the annual fee that have already been included in rates, and only seeks to defer the incremental costs, until such time as the increased fee amount can be 3 included in NW Natural's established rates. While the amounts deferred may not 4 5 be significant, NW Natural seeks this reauthorization because the 2016 increase 6 and the subsequent 2017 increase to the annual fee are not regularly scheduled 7 events, which makes planning for the fee increase difficult to align with ordinary 8 rate case planning. For this reason, the Company respectfully requests the 9 reauthorization to defer the incremental costs of the annual fee.

C.

Proposed Accounting – OAR 860-027-0300(3)(c)

NW Natural proposed to account for the deferred expenses related to
the regulatory fee by recording the deferral in a sub-account of Account 186
(Defer PUC Fee). In the absence of deferred accounting, the Company would
record the incremental increase in expenses in the appropriate sub-account of
FERC Account 909.

D. Estimate of Amounts – OAR 860-027-0300(3)(d)

The Company estimates the amount to be recorded in the deferred
account for the 12-month period beginning March 23, 2017, through March 22,
2018, to be approximately \$283,825.
