7	I. INTRODUCTION			
8	Pursuant to ORS 757.259 and OAR 860-027-0300, Idaho Power Company ("Idaho			
9	Power") hereby requests an accounting order reauthorizing the Company to defer for later			
10	ratemaking treatment costs associated with the Oregon annual regulatory fee beginning			
11	January 1, 2023, and allowed by ORS 756.310. Idaho Power seeks authorization for this			
12	deferral effective during the calendar year 2023. In support of this Application, Idaho Power			
13	states:

II. OAR 860-027-0300(3) REQUIREMENTS

2 A. <u>Description</u>

3 On May 24, 2019, Oregon Governor Kate Brown signed Senate Bill 68, increasing the annual fee imposed on public utilities and telecommunications providers for the purpose of 4 defraying costs of the Commission. The bill allows the Commission to set the annual 5 6 regulatory fee amount established in ORS 757.310(3) to an amount not to exceed 0.45 7 percent, an increase from the then current amount of 0.30 percent. In accordance with ORS 8 757.310(3), on February 24, 2022, the Commission issued Order No. 22-062 authorizing 9 collection of the annual regulatory fee from the public utilities operating in Oregon subject to regulation by the Commission at 0.43 percent of 2021 gross operating revenues. By March 10 11 1 of each year the Commission will issue an order establishing the annual regulatory fee for gross operating revenue derived from electric utility operations in Oregon during the previous 12 calendar year. The fee is due to the Commission April 1 of the year after the calendar year 13 upon which the fee is based. Senate Bill 68 allows for a fee level increase up to 0.45 percent 14 of gross operating revenue. 15

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B. <u>Reasons for Deferral</u>

17 Idaho Power requests reauthorization to defer incremental costs associated with the 18 increase in the Oregon annual regulatory fee, as compared to the annual regulatory fees paid 19 prior to the enactment of Senate Bill 68, effective January 1, 2023. The Company's deferral 20 request in this case is filed pursuant to ORS 757.259(2)(e) and is intended to minimize the 21 frequency of rate changes or the fluctuation of rate levels.

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C. <u>Proposed Accounting</u>

If approved, Idaho Power will record amounts that would be subject to the deferral
order in accordance with the Code of Federal Regulations to the Federal Energy Regulatory
Commission ("FERC") Account 182 – Regulatory Assets with the corresponding entry
recorded to FERC Account 131 – Cash. Absent approval, the amount that would have been

subject to deferral for the Oregon annual regulatory fees would be recorded to FERC Account
 601 – Other Tax (Taxes Other Than Income Taxes).

D. <u>Estimate of Amounts</u>

The Oregon annual regulatory fee prior to the enactment of Senate Bill 68 was 0.30 percent but can increase up to 0.45 percent of the Company's gross operating revenue in Oregon. The Company estimates an increase in costs of approximately \$75,000 based on the fees assessed following the enactment of Senate Bill 68. In accordance with Order No. 05-1070, Idaho Power will accrue interest on the unamortized balance at a rate equal to its authorized weighted average cost of capital most recently approved by the Commission.

11 A copy of the Notice of Application for Deferred Accounting of Oregon Annual 12 Regulatory Fee Expenses and a list of persons served with the Notice are attached to the 13 Application as Attachment A.

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III. OAR 860-027-0300(4) REQUIREMENTS

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A. <u>Entries in the Deferred Account to Date</u>

Attached to the Application as Attachment B is a description and explanation of the entries in this deferred account as of November 30, 2022. In addition, the Company has included the workpapers that support the amounts deferred.

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B. <u>Reason for Continuation of Deferred Accounting</u>

As discussed in detail above, this deferral is intended to capture incremental annual regulatory fee expenses resulting from Senate Bill 68.

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IV. <u>CONCLUSION</u>

For the reasons stated above, Idaho Power respectfully requests that, consistent with ORS 757.259(2)(e), the Commission reauthorize the Company to record and defer incremental Oregon annual regulatory fee expenses resulting from Senate Bill 68 for the January 1, 2023, through December 31, 2023, time period.
