1 Northwest Natural Gas Company, dba NW Natural ("NW Natural" or the 2 "Company") hereby files with the Public Utility Commission of Oregon (the 3 "Commission") this application ("Application") seeking reauthorization to use 4 deferred accounting pursuant to ORS 757.259 and OAR 860-027-0300, for the 12-5 month period beginning February 28, 2023 through February 27, 2024 for all 6 expenses associated with activities and programs developed pursuant to Oregon 7 House Bill 2475, the Energy Affordability Act ("HB 2475"). NW Natural proposed to 8 use a balancing account to track the costs and revenues associated with HB 2475 9 activities and programs. One such program is the Company's Residential Bill 10 Discount Program. In 2022, NW Natural received approval for, and launched, its 11 low-income bill discount program and associated tariff change to facilitate cost 12 recovery of the program.<sup>1</sup>
