## RE: UM 2262 In the Matter of PGE's Request for changes to the Time of Day Evaluation

Portland General Electric (PGE) hereby submits this filing to the Commission requesting a further extension to the Time of Day (TOD) evaluation. PGE seeks Commission Order for an additional 3-month extension for delivery of the evaluation to October 2023.

At the Public Meeting on January 26, 2021, the Commission adopted Staff's recommendation to approve PGE's Advice No. 20-34 (Docket No. ADV 1194) which updated its Schedule 7 Residential Time-of-Use Rate. One of the conditions for approval was, "PGE would submit a comprehensive report, which includes a cost-effectiveness analysis, of its Schedule 7 TOU offerings no later than December 2022. PGE agrees to work with Staff and interested parties on the information and analysis in said report;"<sup>1</sup> In November of 2022, PGE filed a request for an extension for delivery of the evaluation from December 2022 to July 2023 that was approved at the December 27, 2022, public meeting.

PGE has made strides towards completing the evaluation but does not yet have a completed final evaluation and requires some additional time to finish the comprehensive report.

PGE requests Commission consideration of this request by September 5, 2023, to ensure PGE is still in Compliance with Commission direction in ADV 1194.
