## RE: Application for Reauthorization of Certain Deferred Accounts

Dear Ms. Johnson:

Please accept the following information required to reauthorize deferral accounting:

- 1. The expense for which deferred accounting is being reauthorized includes Idaho Power Company's funding of the Northwest Energy Efficiency Alliance.
- 2. Reauthorization of the deferral is requested under ORS 757.259(2)(c).
- 3. Normally, the proposed account for recording the conservation cost deferrals is 182.3, Other Regulatory Assets. However, because of the DSM over-collection, the deferral is being funded from account 254, Other Regulatory Credits, until the over-collection is absorbed.
- 4. The total Oregon deferral amount to be recorded for the 12-month period subsequent to June 30, 2005 is estimated to be \$56,025. This is the NEEA amount based on the system-wide funding of \$1,245,000 and the funding cycle's agreed upon Oregon allocation of 4.5%.
- 5. The Oregon portion of the current balance in the deferred accounts as of December 31, 2004 is \$0.
- 6. The reason to continue the deferred accounting is to comply with the OPUC Order 98-448 that authorized Idaho Power to implement accelerated recovery of Demand Side Management/Conservation (DSM) expenditures and discontinue the Excess Power Supply Cost surcharge.

7. The OPUC order providing the most recent authorization to use each deferred account is 98-448.
