1 4. 2 The parties further agree that the Commission may enter an order assessing civil 3 monetary penalties against Defendant in the amount of \$2,000 under the following terms and 4 conditions: 5 A. Defendant must sign and return this Stipulation within 20 days of the date it was 6 served upon (mailed to) Defendant. B. \$400 becomes due and payable on or before the 30th day following the Commission's 7 8 entry of its order in this case. 9 C. Payment must be by money order made out to the Public Utility Commission of 10 Oregon, and the memo line of the money order must state the "NC" docket number 11 in the caption of this Stipulation. 12 D. Payment of the balance of the penalties (\$1,600) will be suspended and no further 13 penalties will be imposed for the violation alleged in the Complaint unless Defendant fails to comply with all of the terms of this Stipulation and all of the rules adopted by 14 the Oregon Utility Notification Center (OUNC) under ORS 757.552 for a one-year 15 16 period following the date of the Commission's entry of an order. E. Defendant must contact the OUNC Speakers Bureau online at 17 18 www.digsafelyoregon.com or by calling (503) 232-1987 to arrange for and attend a training session on Oregon excavation laws within 45 days following the entry of the 19

F. In the event that Complainant contends that Defendant has not complied with all of the terms of this Stipulation and all OUNC rules for that one-year period, Complainant may reopen this proceeding and petition for imposition of all or a portion of the suspended penalties. In such case, Defendant is entitled to a hearing and to be notified of the basis upon which Complainant contends that compliance has not occurred.
