3	monetary penalties against Defendant in the amount of \$1,000 under the following terms and	
4	conditions	
5	A.	Defendant must sign and return this Stipulation within 20 days of the date it was
6		served upon (mailed to) Defendant.
7	B.	$$200$ becomes due and payable on or before the 30^{th} day following the Commission's
8		entry of its order in this case.
9	C.	Payment must be by <u>money order</u> made out to the <u>Public Utility Commission of</u>
10		Oregon, and the memo line of the money order must state the "NC" docket number
11		in the caption of this Stipulation.
12	D.	Payment of the balance of the penalty (\$800) will be suspended and no further
