1 4. 2 The parties further agree that the Commission may enter an order assessing civil 3 monetary penalties against the Defendant in the amount of \$1,000 under the following terms and 4 conditions: 5 A. Defendant shall sign and return this Stipulation within 20 days of the date it was served 6 upon (mailed to) Defendant. 7 B. Payment of the penalty (\$1,000) is suspended and the penalty shall be waived with no 8 further penalties imposed for the violation alleged in the Complaint unless Defendant 9 fails to comply with all of the terms of this Stipulation and all of the rules adopted by the 10 Oregon Utility Notification Center (OUNC) under ORS 757.552 for a one-year period following the date of the Commission's entry of an order. 11 12 C. In the event that complainant contends that the Defendant has not complied with all of 13 the terms of this Stipulation and all OUNC rules for that one year period, complainant 14 may reopen this proceeding and petition for imposition of all or a portion of the 15 suspended penalties. In such case Defendant shall be entitled to a hearing and to be 16 notified of the basis upon which complainant contends that compliance has not occurred. 17 5. 18 This Stipulation is conditioned upon final approval of its terms by the Commission.
