SUBJECT: Frontier Communications Northwest Inc., Docket No PL 51/Advice No. 044SPL, Standardizes the naming and descriptions of nonrecurring charges and removes obsolete billing codes.

I have reviewed this filing and recommend that an acknowledgement letter be sent. The filing is effective October 31, 2016, and was filed October 27, 2016. The company proposes to standardize the naming and descriptions of nonrecurring charges and remove obsolete billing codes in the Price List.

This filing comports with the company's revised tariff approved by the Commission in Docket No. ADV378/Advice No. 1049 effective October 31, 2016. The approved tariff change standardized both text and installation charges by renaming and restructuring nonrecurring charges.

This filing does not change the conditions of service, the terms, the rates, nor cause the withdrawal of any service.

The filing complies with Oregon Revised Statutes (ORS) 759.175, which requires telecommunications utilities to submit tariff filings to the Commission whenever a telecommunications utility intends to change its rates, terms, or conditions of service. This filing was submitted on October 27, 2016, and thus, complies with Frontier *Price Plan*, Section Q, which requires price list changes to be filed at least one day prior to their effective dates.
