SUBJECT: CENTURYTEL OF OREGON AND CENTURYTEL OF EASTERN OREGON: (Docket No. PL64/Advice No. PL 17-002) Grandfathers certain Central Office Type services. *BH*

I have reviewed this filing and recommend that an acknowledgement letter be sent. The filing was submitted on June 8, 2017, and will go into effect on June 9, 2017. CenturyTel of Oregon and CenturyTel of Eastern Oregon (CenturyTel) propose to grandfather the Pure Broadband Bundle and the Pure Broadband Bundle competitive response.

While these bundles will no longer be available to new customers CenturyTel states there is no change to the rates or to the service for existing customers. As long as CenturyTel offers the service and the customer makes no changes and remains at the same location the service will be available.

The services being grandfathered are in CenturyTel's Oregon Price List Packaged Services, Section 5, 1st Revised Page 33 and in COMPETITIVE RESPONSE OFFERS AND PROMOTIONS, Section 16, 4th Revised Page 1.

A telecommunications utility is allowed, under Oregon Administrative Rules (OAR) 860-032-0020(15), to grandfather a service without a sunset date by filing a tariff which designates the filing as grandfathered. Grandfathering a service without a sunset date is not considered abandonment of service under the rule. No sunset date is proposed in this filing for the grandfathered bundles, and therefore, this filing does not constitute an abandonment of service under the Commission's rules.

This filing will have no effect on annual revenues.
