NOTICE OF SPECIAL PUBLIC MEETING AND RULEMAKING HEARING

On the morning of April 26, 2022, the Commission will convene a workshop to discuss proposed Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity (CPCN) rules and these proposed rules' interaction with Oregon's Statewide Land Use Planning Goals, local land use permitting and approvals, and the Energy Facilities and Siting Council process.¹ In the afternoon of April 26, 2022, the Commission will hold a rulemaking hearing in this docket to take comment on any issues associated with CPCN rules.

During the workshop, Commissioners will ask questions to representatives from the Oregon Department of Energy (ODOE) and Department of Land Conservation and Development (DLCD). Following the Commissioner discussion with ODOE and DLCD, local land use officials will be invited to make comment and engage in discussion, followed by any stakeholder engaged in the Staff-led informal rulemaking process.

Following the conclusion of the morning workshop, an afternoon rulemaking hearing will be held at which any person may offer comment on any portion of the proposed CPCN rules, including those portions not discussed during the morning workshop.
