The purpose of the prehearing conference will be to identify parties, to address the scope of this docket, and to establish a procedural schedule. The Commission strongly encourages any person wanting to participate as a party in these proceedings to file a petition to intervene before the prehearing conference. *See* OAR 860-001-0300. This docket was opened in connection with docket UG 221, Northwest Natural Gas Company, dba NW Natural's most recent general rate case. Order No. 12-437, the final order in that docket, ordered additional proceedings to address unresolved issues regarding the prudence of certain NW Natural's environmental cleanup costs, and to address the mechanism for recovery of those costs. Separately, the Commission finds that the rate spread issue raised by Northwest Industrial Gas Users in docket UG 221 remains an open issue that should be addressed in this docket.

Consequently, the Commission intends to address the following issues in this docket:

- 1. The prudence of NW Natural's environmental remediation costs;
- 2. The appropriate deadband to be applied to recovery of environmental remediation costs;
- 3. The appropriate application of the earnings test ordered in docket UG 221; and
- 4. The appropriate rate spread to apply to recoverable costs.

During the prehearing conference, the parties may raise any other issues they believe should be included in this docket.

The possibility of phasing this docket or handling certain issues through briefing (rather than testimony) will be discussed. The parties should be prepared to advise the Commission of any time constraints that will affect the time-frame for resolution of these issues.
