## **MEMORANDUM**

The Commission will be adopting temporary rules implementing SB 408 at a special public meeting on September 14, 2005. Temporary rules are only in effect for six months. Therefore, it seems prudent to notify interested persons of the schedule for the permanent rule docket as early as possible.
