Rulemaking Regarding Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity Rule.

On July 1, 2022, a revised set of proposed rules was published in the Oregon Bulletin and noticed on the docket.¹ In addition to the revised, proposed rules to govern the process and criteria for consideration of petitions for Certificates of Public Convenience and Necessity (CPCN) rules, the notice also contains the date for the rulemaking hearing (August 4, 2022, at 1:30 p.m.) via zoom.
