RULING

**DISPOSITION: VERIZON’S REQUEST FOR A 25-DAY
EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE RESPONSES
GRANTED**

On February 26, 2004, Verizon Northwest Inc. (Verizon) filed a petition for arbitration of an amendment to interconnection agreements with competitive local exchange carriers and commercial mobile radio service providers in Oregon. On March 12, 2004, Verizon indicated that it may make modifications to the proposed amendment on March 19, 2004. Accordingly, Verizon requests that the date for filing responses to its petition be extended to 25 days after March 19, 2004.

Verizon’s request is granted. Responses to Verizon’s petition for arbitration shall be made on April 13, 2004.
