DISPOSITION: HEARING WAIVED; EXTENSION GRANTED; SCHEDULING CONFERENCE TO BE HELD

On March 18, 2005, Qwest Corporation (Qwest) filed a letter with the Commission on its own behalf and on behalf of Covad Communications Company (Covad) indicating that the parties had agreed to waive hearing currently scheduled for April 7 and April 8, 2005. According to counsel for Qwest, "the parties would agree to submit the matter based on the prefiled testimony, exhibits, post-hearing briefs and the parties' ability to submit excerpts of oral hearing transcripts from the Covad/Qwest arbitration in the other states that have had live hearings." The parties also requested a two-day extension of time (until March 23, 2005) in which Covad may file rebuttal testimony, and requested further that a prehearing conference be set for the week of March 28, 2005, to set a post-hearing brief schedule.

RULING

The hearing in this proceeding is CANCELLED.

Covad Communications Company shall file its rebuttal testimony no later than March 23, 2005. A scheduling conference will be held the week of March 28, for which separate notice will be issued.
