On June 20, 2005, a prehearing conference was held in this matter in Salem, Oregon. Martin Hansen and Sarah Wallace appeared via telephone on behalf of Applicant. At the conference, the parties noted that Applicant had filed a motion to dismiss Mr. Alvis' protest. The parties further agreed that in the event the Commission grants the motion to dismiss, Staff would process the application pursuant to standard procedures; if the Commission denies the motion, a further conference would be held to establish a procedural schedule.
