
**DISPOSITION: MOTION GRANTED; TIME EXTENDED IN WHICH  
TO FILE AMENDED COMPLAINT**

On October 15, 2009, The Northwest Public Communications Council (NPCC) counsel filed an Unopposed Motion for Enlargement of Time to File an Amended Complaint (Motion), requesting that the time for filing the amended complaint be extended until November 16, 2009. Counsel for NPCC indicated that Qwest does not oppose the Motion.

**RULING**

This Motion is the fourth such request since the substitution of Plaintiff's counsel in July. Although I find that the further delay of one month will not unduly delay the proceedings or burden the record, I will not grant further extensions of time without a demonstration of need. The Unopposed Motion for Enlargement of Time to File an Amended Complaint is GRANTED.
