DISPOSITION: MOTION TO DISMISS REPLY DEADLINE EXTENDED; PETITION TO INTERVENE CONDITIONALLY GRANTED

The petition is conditionally granted. Any person wishing to contest the petition may do so within 10 days of service of the petition. If no person contests it, the decision to grant the petition shall be final.
