DISPOSITION: LC 33 SCHEDULE REINSTATED/ UM 1080 RESPONSE DUE APRIL 23, 2004

On April 12, 2004, Administrative Law Judges Allan J. Arlow and Kathryn A. Logan (the ALJs), *sua sponte*, suspended the procedural schedule in Docket LC 33 and set April 22, 2004, as the date for parties to respond to the April 12, 2004, Motion of Northwest Independent Power Producers Coalition (NIPPC) asking the Commission to issue an order allowing additional bidding regarding Portland General Electric Company's (PGE's) proposed Port Westward plant. Brief procedural conferences were held by the ALJs with NIPPC and PGE on April 14 and 16, 2004, regarding the impact of our Ruling on the procedural processes in the respective dockets.
